Fern is a composite school offering programs from Full Day Kindergarten to Grade 8 in English, Full Day Kindergarten (SK) to Grade 6 in French Immersion, and a Grade 4 to 8 Extended French program.

High Park is home to many species of wildlife and contains an outstanding concentration of rare plant species.

### **Sir Casimir Gzowski Park** about a 7 minute walk - 0.52 KM

1755 Lake Shore Blvd W

Sunnyside's western section, from the Humber River to west of the Bathing Pavilion is named in honour of Casimir Gzowski, a pioneer engineer in the building of railways in Canada. The park houses a monument built in the 1960s that has displays of his personal history. The park contains a children's playground and picnicking areas, a food concession stand and a storm water catchment pond. At the western end of Gzowski Park is the Queen Elizabeth Way Monument, relocated from its location between the east and west lanes of the then Queen Elizabeth Way, which had its starting point from the Humber River. The park is now the site of another relocation, a Joy Oil heritage gas station from the 1930s. Sunnyside Gus Ryder Outdoor Pool is here as well.

Budapest Park can be found at the foot of Parkside Drive along the shore of Lake Ontario. It's located to the east of Sunnyside Gus Ryder Pool and includes a fun playground that's home to playful toy dinosaurs, an ornamental fountain, a wading pool and part of the Martin Goodman Trail. The trees make it a great place to hang out and have a picnic. A beautiful view of Lake Ontario and the west end of the GTA (Greater Toronto Area) can also be found. Walk a few minutes to the west and you'll find Sunnyside Beach, a great place for a swim.

It is a popular place for picnics and the wading pool is a favourite spot for visiting children. Sunnyside is one of a series of parks along the waterfront that has a boardwalk for pedestrians and the Martin Goodman Trail for cyclists and multi-use purposes. On the east side of the park you will find Sunnyside Pavilion and Sunnyside Gus Ryder Pool and on the west Sir Casmir Gzowski Park with a great playground. Throughout Toronto's history Sunnyside Beach has been a popular spot to cool off in the summer.


